## PERI-IMPLANT COMPLICATIONS AND MANAGEMENT OF TEETH WITH POOR PROGNOSIS

The report of high percentages of implants that survive or remain in the mouth has created a perception that implants are a treatment suitable for all. However, implant failure etiology, diagnosis, risk factors and treatment have become the new challenge. Several treatment modalities have been proposed to deal with peri-implant disease including surgical and non-surgical therapy. Despite the various modalities, there is little consensus regarding which protocols are to be used and at what point. These observations raise some important questions. What are the factors that justify the extraction of a tooth in order to place a dental implant? Are we using dental implants to replace missing teeth or to replace teeth?

The extensive knowledge related to the treatment of periodontal and endodontal disease does not extend to implants, yet when comparing the prognosis of a tooth or an implant, our clinical judgment often rules for the implant. But how can this judgment be made if our understanding of implant prognosis and implant complications is not clear yet. Therefore, this presentation aims to summarize significant factors and provide a rationale for the etiology and management of peri-implant disease, tooth maintenance, and options for the treatment of teeth with poor prognosis.
