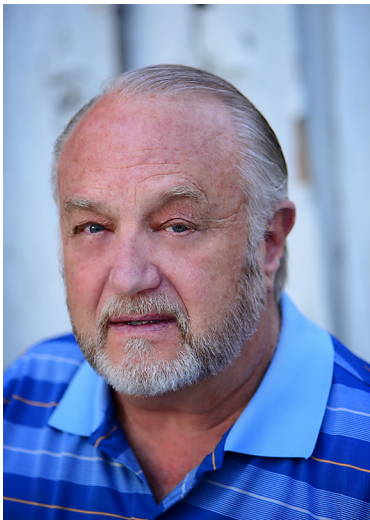
FORENSIC IDENTIFICATION

Dr. Doug Wyler is currently an instructor at the Detective Training Unit of the LA Police Department Homicide School and a guest instructor at the College of Sciences, University of Utah. He is also a Research Associate at the San Diego Museum of Man.

Dr. Wyler held various professional and academic positions. He was a Research Anthropologist at Brigham Young University; an expert witness in Forensic Odontology and has been a consultant in Forensic Identification at the Riverside County Coroner. He has extensive experience in Anthropology and Odontology Forensic Cases and has been involved with Search and Recovery in Mass Disasters, Aircraft Crashes, Train Derailments and Gas Explosions.
